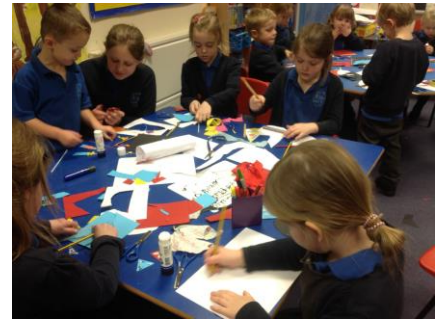
KS1 Multiskills Festival
