End of School Day Arrangements for September

At Caythorpe Primary School we continuously review our policies and procedures to ensure that we deliver the best education possible for our children. To enable us to do this it is essential that we provide staff with appropriate training and continued professional development opportunities so that they can upskill themselves and keep up to date with new initiatives and current legislation. With the current teaching and learning hours that we have in place at school, staff often struggle to attend meetings or training that are available after school. In light of this and the fact that we are currently teaching for longer than the government recommended daily teaching and learning hours we are making some minor changes to the timings of the end of the school day, which will begin in September 2020.

The new timings for the end of the school day in September will be as follows:

- Reception & KS1 will finish at 3.20pm
- KS2 will finish at 3.25pm

We appreciate your support in regard to these new arrangements. We hope these changes will ensure that staff can attend valuable training that is available after school to support them in delivering the best possible education for your children.
