Easter Trail

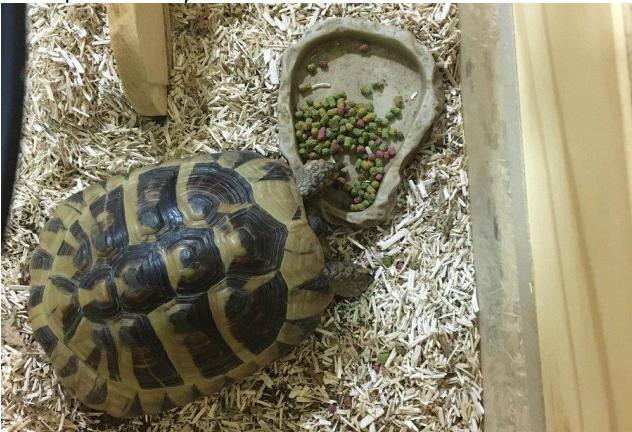
The FSA are organising an Easter Trail around Caythorpe village on Monday 22nd April. They would be delighted for as many families as possible to join them! More details to follow.
