They worked with Joy Lucas and Sue Woodhouse to create a passport for the men who lost their lives during the Great War. They were fascinated to discover how many soldiers actually died during the war and how young some of the soldiers were when they lost their lives.

The remembrance poppy is an artificial flower, which has been used since 1921 to commemorate military personnel, who have died in war, and represents a common or field poppy.
