## Caythorpe Primary School to Buckingham Palace

The distance from Caythorpe Primary School to Buckingham Palace is 120.4 miles via the A1, which equates to approximately 253,440 steps. A number of staff members and KS2 pupils have got their pedometers ready to see if they can walk from Caythorpe to London in 21 days! It will be great fun, engaging, interactive and it will help us to be a little more active every day. I have broken the total number of steps down into days to help me to plan my steps across the 21 days. However it does not matter how many steps you do each day as long as you reach the target of 253,440 in the 21 days. All pupils from Reception to Year 5 should have received a letter regarding how to consent for your child to receive this year's flu vaccination. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable family and friends by preventing the spread of flu. The vaccination date allocated to our school is 7<sup>th</sup> Oct 2019.

The vaccination is free and is a quick and simple spray up the nose. This vaccine is a yearly vaccine. All vaccinated children will be given a sticker or an ink stamp on their hand.
