Narnia

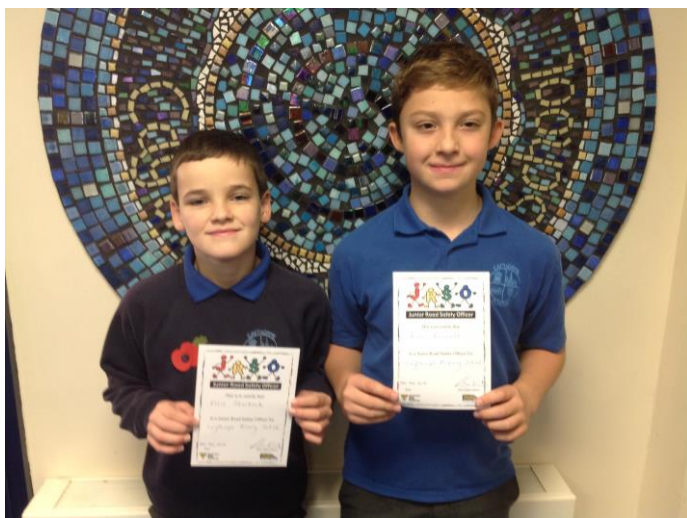
In Narnia, we have worked really hard on making Owl models. We used balloons and paper mache and we are really pleased with how they have turned out!
