1.00- 2.00 - Class Activities

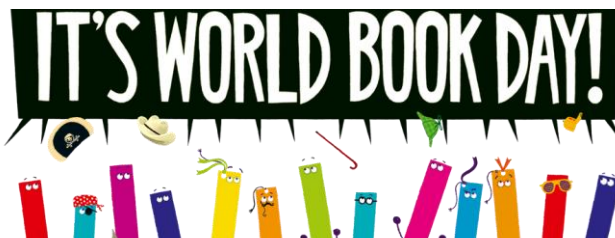
2.00 - 2.10 - Playtime
