Children are welcomed onto the playground at 8:45am to ensure they are in school ready to begin their lessons promptly at 9:00am.

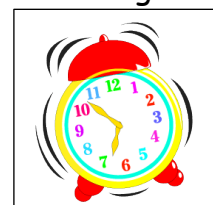
When a child arrives late at school, they miss valuable learning time. This is something that we must ensure does not happen.

Lateness adds up over time and can make a huge difference to children's learning time in school. **Every minute counts!**

Arriving **10 minutes** late each day = Nearly **1 ½ weeks** per year!

Arriving **20 minutes** late each day = Nearly **2 ½ weeks** per year!

Arriving **30 minutes** late each day = **4 weeks** per year!
